

## **Shelter Incidents**

**On 12-15-08, Burbank Fire requested that BPD officers respond to the Shelter regarding a mentally disturbed person. The client was subsequently transported to Olive View for treatment.**

**On 12-28-08, BPD responded to the Shelter to assist BFD with a victim of an assault. The crime occurred outside the City of Burbank. The victim (client) was advised.**

**On 12-30-08, a patrol officer observed two subjects loitering on Valhalla in front of the Armory. The officer learned that one of the subjects was a Shelter employee and the other was a client who volunteers at the Shelter. The officer was informed that some clients, who are employed, do not use the bus to arrive at or leave the Shelter. A field ID card was completed on both subjects.**

**On 01-07-09, Shelter staff called BPD regarding an occupied vehicle that had been parked in front of the Shelter with its engine running for two hours. BPD officers arrived on scene 5 minutes later and were unable to locate it.**

**On 01-14-09, a patrol officer conducted a traffic stop on a client's vehicle. The stop was cleared "other" and I have no further information at this time.**

**On 01-15-09, BPD units were dispatched to the Shelter regarding an unknown problem. A client was being 415 with the Shelter staff. He was advised and remained at the Shelter.**

**On 01-17-09, BPD units were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a battery report. Burbank Fire also responded to the scene. BPD officers determined that the crime occurred in Glendale and the victim (client) was not desirous of a report.**

**On 01-19-09, BPD units were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client creating a disturbance and refusing to leave the shelter. The subject was subsequently advised.**

**On 01-27-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client disturbing the peace. The client had gotten into a mutual combat fight with 3 other clients. All four subjects were asked to leave the Shelter by Shelter staff. BPD was able to locate only one of the clients who was FI'd and released.**

**On 01-28-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a drunk client. The subject arrived at the shelter and was refused entry because he was drunk. He then chose to sleep on the grass in front of the armory. He was subsequently arrested for being drunk in public and booked at BPD.**

**On 01-28-09, a BPD officer was conducting an area check at the Shelter and was flagged down by staff members regarding a client creating a disturbance. The subject had gotten into an argument with another client over a blanket and was asked to leave the shelter. He was FI'd and released.**

**On 01-28-09, BPD received a call from the Shelter staff regarding a fight among the clients at the shelter. The officers had just cleared the shelter from the above incident. BPD officers contacted a bleeding client in the Shelter and another walking away from the Shelter. Burbank Fire was called to treat the victim. The Victim refused to speak to the officers about the incident and he also refused medical treatment.**

**On 1-31-09, BPD received a call from the Shelter staff regarding one client striking another. The Victim told officers that after a brief argument over a travel bag, the Suspect punched him once and fled. Officers searched for the suspect, but did not find him. Officers took a battery report.**

**On 02-10-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding two clients creating a disturbance. Both men were subsequently arrested for being drunk in public.**

**On 02-11-09, a BPD officer contacted a client outside of the shelter.**

**On 02-14-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client who called BPD and stated that he had been assaulted earlier and was on his way to the Shelter to "beat up" his assailant. BPD units checked the area and were unable to locate the client.**

**On 02-16-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the shelter regarding a client creating a disturbance. The client was ejected from the Shelter, and given a bus pass.**

**On 02-17-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client creating a disturbance. The client was asked to leave the shelter and was provided with a bus token.**

**On 02-18-09, a BPD officer was dispatched to the Shelter regarding a battery report. A client reported that another client had pushed him and spit on him. The Victim was unable to locate the Suspect in the Shelter. A crime report was taken.**

**On 02-23-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client who was threatening suicide. The client was transported to Olive View Hospital and held on a 72 hour psychiatric hold.**

**On 02-25-09, BPD officers were dispatched to the Shelter regarding a disturbance. Shelter staff stated that a subject was causing a disturbance over parking issues. All parties were advised.**

**On 03-10-09, BPD was dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client creating a disturbance. The female client was asked to leave the Shelter by staff members. She ultimately left the shelter.**

**On 03-11-09, Shelter staff called BPD regarding a client that was dropped off at the Shelter who wandered into the Fry's parking lot. The responding officers were unable to locate the client.**

**During the 2008/2009 BWS season, BPD has responded to the Shelter 22 times which resulted in 3 arrests and 2 transports for mental health problems.**

## **Burbank Fire Responses**

**On 12-12-08, BFD Engine 13 and RA 13 responded to the Shelter for a medical problem. After being treated by paramedics, the client was left at the Shelter.**

**On 12-15-08, BFD Engine 13 and RA 13 responded to the Shelter for a medical problem. After being treated by paramedics, the client was determined to have mental issues and BPD was notified.**

**On 12-28-08, BFD Engine 13 and R/A 13 responded to the shelter for an assault victim. The client was examined at the scene and refused further treatment or transportation to Saint Joseph's Medical Center.**

**On 12-28-08, BFD Engine 11 responded to a small fire at a homeless encampment at Front Street and Verdugo Ave. The fire had burned personal items. BFD was unable to determine the origin of the fire. The fire was near the Burbank Winter Shelter pick-up location at 451 Front Street, but we are unable to determine if this incident is related to the Winter Shelter.**

**On January 5, 2009, BFD Engine 13 and R/A 13 responded to the Shelter for a medical problem. The client was treated at the scene and released. He was not transported to the hospital.**

**On 1-28-09, RA 13 and Engine 13 responded to the Shelter to aid the victim of a fight (see above mentioned incident for 1-28-09).**

**On 2-1-09, RA 13 and Engine 13 responded to the area of the shelter to aid an elderly woman who flagged down an officer for assistance. She was transported to the hospital for a complaint of leg pain.**

**On 02-15-09, at 1853 hours, BFD responded to the Shelter regarding a client with a medical problem. He was medically evaluated by BFD and was left with the shelter staff.**

**On 02-26-09, BFD responded to the Shelter regarding a medical problem. A female was transported to SJMC for further treatment.**

**On 03-10-09, BFD units responded to the shelter for a female client with a medical problem. She was evaluated and left at the scene.**

**On 03-12-09, BFD units responded to the Shelter for a male client with a medical problem. He was subsequently transported to SJMC for further treatment.**

**Total BFD responses to the shelter to date are 11, with 3 transported to the hospital.**

## **Pacific Park**

**On 02-25-09, while conducting a routine check of the park, a BPD officer contacted a homeless man sleeping in the Men's bathroom at Pacific Park. A Field Interview card was completed.**

**During the 2008/2009 BWS season, BPD has responded to 1 incident at Pacific Park.**

## **City Wide**

**BPD received complaints from the Metro-Link security guard that homeless persons have been taking over the restrooms at the Metro-Link station and soiling them. A DPR was activated by Patrol to address the issue. It is unknown if these persons are related to the Shelter or its pick-up location on Front street.**

**On 12-28-08, a BPD officer observed a fire at a homeless encampment at Verdugo and Front. BFD was called to the scene (see above incident). The owner of the property fled the scene prior to our arrival. BPD was unable to locate or ID the owner of the property.**

**On 02-10-09, BPD units were dispatched to an incident on the Olive overpass involving a taxi cab. A BWS client committed an unprovoked violent attack on a cab driver while the cab was moving at approximately 40 mph. The taxi driver was not seriously hurt and was refused medical treatment. The client was subsequently arrested for attempted kidnapping and assault.**

**On 02-11-09, at 2100 hours, a BWS client was located loitering around a closed business at 321 E. Alameda.**

**On 02-17-09, BPD officers contacted a homeless man at Verdugo and Hollywood Way. The BWS client stated that he disliked staying at the Shelter and would rather stay on the streets. He was advised.**

**On 02-18-09, BPD officers responded to the Laundromat at 405 E. Irving regarding a suspicious person. A BWS client was located in the business. A Field Interview card was completed and he was released.**

**On 02-24-09, BPD officers were dispatched to Burger King regarding a subject causing a disturbance. Ultimately, the officers contacted 3 homeless persons who were begging at Burger King.**

**On 02-24-09, BPD officers contacted a homeless female who was sleeping at a closed business at Flower St. and Valencia Ave. She was advised and sent on her way.**

**On 02-25-09, BPD officers contacted a female BWS client at Burbank Blvd and San Fernando Road regarding loitering. There is no further information.**

**On 03-03-09, BPD officers were dispatched to 306 W. Valencia Avenue regarding a suspicious person loitering at a neighbor's residence. The subjects were 2 homeless persons who had been drinking. A field identification card was completed on each subject.**

**On 03-04-09, BPD officers contacted a homeless man with mental issues who was loitering at Saint Finbar Church. The church was closed at the time. A field identification card was completed.**

**The following incident occurred on 03-01-09, but was not reported on last week's report. A BWS client was arrested for drunk in public and resisting arrest after he had been found passed out in the alley at Colgin Court and Glenoaks Blvd.**

**On 03-10-09, BPD officers conducted a field interview of a BWS client for trespassing. The client was sleeping in the Ralphs store parking lot at 2600 W. Victory Blvd.**

**On 03-11-09, BPD officers contacted a homeless man who was loitering at Flower St. and Providencia Ave . The subject was possession of possible stolen recyclables. A field interview card was completed.**

**During the 2008/2009 BWS season, city wide, there have been a total of 33 BWS related Field Interview's or calls for service and 2 arrests.**

## **Misc**

**On 01-14-09, a BPD detective was reviewing the sex registrant files and learned that a homeless sex registrant was staying at the Burbank Winter Shelter. By law, because he is homeless, the man is required to register every 30 days. On January 08, 2009, he completed a registration form with LAPD that indicated that he is moving out of their jurisdiction to Burbank. He listed his new address as 3800 Valhalla Drive (the Burbank Winter Shelter). On January 12, 2009, he registered with the Burbank PD and gave his new address as 3800 Valhalla Drive. The man followed the law by properly registering himself out of LAPD jurisdiction and into ours. The man spent 4 nights at the Shelter.**

**Last week, (Feb 24-March 2) BPD was notified by Eimago personnel that upon further review of its records, there have been a total of 8 sex registrants who have stayed at the shelter since its opening on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. Prior to this, Eimago reported having 4 sex registrants housed in the Shelter.**

**Eimago discovered the additional number of registrants when it conducted an in depth review of all of its clients. According to Eimago, all of these clients had stayed at the Shelter prior to January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009. In addition, BPD was advised that several of the clients were relocated prior to spending a full night at the Shelter.**
