

**Burbank Winter Shelter Program
Council Report
March 10th – March 15th, 2009**

Attendance

The Shelter opened its doors on Monday, December 1st. The last day of operation was Sunday, March 15th. The average nightly attendance for the last week was 75. Below are the attendance numbers for the last week.

*These numbers were obtained from Eimago and represent the total number of clients served in Burbank only. Clients who stayed at the Glendale Armory or at the Union Rescue Mission were not counted.

Pacific Park

There were no incidents relating to the Burbank Winter Shelter at Our Children's Place, the pre-school located at Pacific Park.

There were no incidents relating to the Burbank Winter Shelter at Pacific Park during the last week.

During the 2008/2009 BWS season, BPD has responded to 1 incident at Pacific Park.

Shelter Incidents

There were two incidents at the Shelter in the last week.

On 03-10-09, BPD was dispatched to the Shelter regarding a client creating a disturbance. The female client was asked to leave the Shelter by staff members. She ultimately left the shelter.

On 03-11-09, Shelter staff called BPD regarding a client that was dropped off at the Shelter who wandered into the Fry's parking lot. The responding officers were unable to locate the client.

During the 2008/2009 BWS season, BPD has responded to the Shelter 22 times which resulted in 3 arrests and 2 transports for mental health problems.

Burbank Fire Responses

BFD had two responses to the Shelter in the last week.

On 03-10-09, BFD units responded to the shelter for a female client with a medical problem. She was evaluated and left at the scene.

On 03-12-09, BFD units responded to the Shelter for a male client with a medical problem. He was subsequently transported to SJMC for further treatment.

BFD had no responses to the pick-up location on Front Street in the last week. BFD has never had a response to the pick-up location during the 2008/2009 BWS season.

Total BFD responses to the shelter to date are 11, with 3 transported to the hospital.

City Wide

There were 2 city wide incidents relating to the Shelter during the last week.

On 03-10-09, BPD officers conducted a filed interview of a BWS client for trespassing. The client was sleeping in the Ralphs store parking lot at 2600 W. Victory Blvd.

On 03-11-09, BPD officers contacted a homeless man who was loitering at Flower St. and Providencia Ave . The subject was possession of possible stolen recyclables. A field interview card was completed.

During the 2008/2009 BWS season, city wide, there have been a total of 33 BWS related Field Interview's or calls for service and 2 arrests.

Misc

Eimago states that they have begun a taxi voucher program where if a client is removed from the Shelter, they are placed in a taxi and driven to another shelter outside of Burbank.

Additional info - all clients are supposed to arrive at and leave from the Shelter on the bus. However, there are exceptions. Some clients work and are unable to meet the bus schedule. Other clients also work at the Shelter. Clients who work are not required to arrive or leave by the bus. They are reportedly the only walk-ins allowed at the Shelter.

The Burbank Winter Shelter program has ended for 2008/2009 winter season.
