Pacific Park

City Wide

There was no city wide contacts reported that were related to homeless issues during the last week.

Misc

There was a lot of confusion last week due to the closure of the Armory for training. The National Guard stated that the Armory will be closed once a month for 3 days so that they can accomplish their required training. Eimago (the organization contracted to run the Shelter) made an agreement with the Burbank Salvation Army facility to house the clients during the National Guard drill weekends. The first Drill Weekend closure was December 5-7. However on Friday December 5th, the agreement between the Salvation Army and Eimago fell apart due to a paperwork snafu. The Clients were housed at the Union Mission downtown last weekend. For the future, both parties believe that an agreement can be reached between them that would allow the clients to stay at the Salvation Army during future National Guard drill weekends.
